TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE



1. All PSOAS tenants, who have signed the tenancy agreement, are allowed to use CampusNet Internet service.
2. After signing the CampusNet agreement the user must obey the network rules of PSOAS, these terms, other given rules, show good Internet manners and pay for services according to the current price list.
3. The person who has the possession of the apartment in which the CampusNet will be connected must fulfil the requirements in section 1.
4. The person who has signed the connection agreement is responsible for using the network connection properly as well as for all consequences due to misuse of the network.
5. In cases of misuse, PSOAS can disconnect the connection without a period of notice. In addition, the person can be billed for any costs related to solving the misuse or if the misuse causes network reworking. The third party that is the target of the misuse may also claim damages.
6. You may not let someone else use your network connection. This includes letting someone else use your user name or creating a user name for a person who does not fulfill the requirements listed in Section 1, as well as lending the physical connection point to someone else.
7. The user is personally responsible for the protection of his/her files. PSOAS takes no responsibility for data security.
8. User name cracking attempts and break-in attempts on other computers, networks or other communications devices and intentionally searching for breaches in security, are forbidden.
9. The network, the CampusNet connection or the computers in the network may not be used for commercial purposes.
10. Spreading commercial materials or other copyright law protected materials in the network without permission of the legal owner of the copyright is strictly forbidden.
11. Private or public servers, BBS-systems or similar are not allowed in CampusNet network. To avoid misunderstandings, please contact network maintenance for guidance. Chain letters, bulk mails as well as spreading materials in the network against laws and good manners is forbidden.
12. Network maintenance is not responsible for the functionality and configuration of users' equipment.
13. When the connection agreement is approved and the connection fee is paid the user is given a user name and a password, setup procedures and other materials required.
14. All faults and misuse of the network have to be reported to network maintenance, immediately.
15. PSOAS or network maintenance take no responsibility for any direct or indirect damages caused by thunderstorms, outages or other unexpected events, including faults in equipment.
16. For the network connection PSOAS charges the current connection fee. The connection fee is also charged when the tenant is moving to another PSOAS apartment connected to the network. For CampusNet 10/10 Mb/s connection a current monthly fee will be charged, as well.
17. Note that repairing and checking the faults of tenant's equipment is chargeable service. The responsibility of PSOAS ends at the data connector box on the wall.
18. DNA Services Ltd has maintenance outages every month's second Wednesday between 00.30 am - 06.00 am.
19. In addition you need to follow the rules and instructions of DNA Services Ltd.
