

According to the ordinances of the city of Oulu, the waste disposal in the real estate has to be sorted.

Please, follow these guidelines.



ORGANIC WASTE (composter)

YES	NO
perishable food and leftovers fruit and vegetable peel, egg shells fish leftovers and small bones coffee filter papers and tea bags garden waste	plastic, metal, glass, porcelain textile, rubber or leather plastic covered paper cigarette stubs, ash, vacuum cleaner bags napkins, sanitary towels hazardous waste, liquid
Put all organic waste into the composter or into the biowaste container. Collect the biowaste in a pot in your own kitchen. The waste may not be wrapped into paper or put into a plastic bag, not even into a bag biodegradable material. Pour out the biowaste as such into the composter or the biowaste container.	

ENERGY WASTE

YES	NO
packaging plastics (not PVC) plastics (not PVC) wooden packagings polystyrene textiles paper towels dirty paper and cardboard	PVC plastics biowaste impregnated wood stone, sand hygiene products (sanitary towels, nappies, adhesive bandage) hazardous waste cigarette stubs and ash

TETRAPACKS

YES	NO
liquid packs tetra packs lined with aluminium (e.g. milk, juice, cream, sour cartons or paper packages for dry products paper bags egg cells, toilet paper rolls casings for toy and cosmetics, disposable cardboard products etc.	dirty packages and packages that are not rinsed
Rinse and trickle the liquid packs. Flatten the packages and put one package into another to save space.	

CARDBOARD (cardboard shelf)

YES	NO
pizza and cardboard boxes, cardboard in general brown kraft paper, crinkled cardboard packages	wet or dry cardboard foil, polystyrene or plastic packages
Flatten the packages into a small size and fold large cardboard boxes so they do not fall down from the shelf.	

GLASS

YES	NO
glass bottles and jars any other coloured or colourless glass Flush the bottles and jars	light bulbs, fluorescent lamps porcelain or ceramics corks, caps

MINOR METALS

YES	NO
tins, metal caps and lids metal kitchen utilities clean foil and aluminium moulds small metal machine parts, tools other small metal objects	bicycles, motors (or parts of them), exhaust pipes microwave oven, vacuum cleaners TVs, radios, computers, videos, clockradios accumulators and batteries

PAPER RECYCLING (green container)

YES	NO
newspapers and magazines copying and office paper and prints advertisements, telephone books envelopes (also window envelopes) books without covers	dirty and wet paper soft paper aluminized and plastic coted paper cardboard and kraft paper

BATTERIES (red mailbox)

YES	NO
batteries (also telephone batteries e.g.)	accumulators of motorvehicles e.g.

FLUORESCENT LAMPS/ENERGY SAVING LAMPS

YES	NO
fluorescent lamps energy saving lamps	glow bulbs
Pleas, don't break the fluorescent lamps. Put them carefully into the box.	

MIXED WASTE (gray container)

YES	NO
coated fabrics, shower curtains, folders, plastic folders glow bulbs cigarette stubs and cold ash cat litter	sortable waste suitable for recycling
Plese, see to that the lids of the containers are always closed (mind the birds)	

YOU HAVE TO TAKE FOLLOWING WASTE DIRECTLY TO RUSKO WASTE CENTER OR TO ANOTHER AUTHORIZED COLLECTION POINT

Large waste metal objects (dish-washers, microwave ovens) electrical goods and electronical scrap (refrigerators, freezers, televisions, computer monitors, mainframe computer, stereos, radios, clock radios, videos, vacuum cleaners etc.) scrap vehicles, tyres of cars, motorcycles, and mopeds furniture
